Preparing for the Unexpected: The Value of Proactive Leadership in a Crisis

From hurricanes Harvey, Irma, and Maria to the California wildfires in 2017, the Federal Emergency Management Agency, under Brock Long's leadership, helped communities navigate through a string of devastating natural disasters. From a storm-battered Puerto Rico to the tornado-scarred plains of the Midwest, one thing that remains true, regardless of the situation on the ground, is that having a plan in place to manage the crisis goes a long way in helping the community heal more quickly. Hear behind-the-scenes anecdotes from Long's experiences, reflect on how to prepare for the unexpected, and gain takeaways on leadership approaches to crisis and disaster management.

BROCK LONG served as Administrator of the Federal Emergency Management Agency from 2017–2019. Confirmed by the U.S. Senate with strong bipartisan support (95-4), Brock is the youngest Administrator to hold the office. While serving as Administrator, Brock coordinated the federal government's response to 144 Presidentially declared disasters and 112 wildfires, including three of the nation's most devastating hurricanes and five of the worst wildfires ever experienced. During his tenure, nearly \$44 billion of disaster activity occurred under the various federal recovery programs.
