




Over 70% of NYPA's generation comes from zero-emission hydropower resources.

NYPA has also been helping to fuel New York's vision for offshore wind, with 9 GW of commitments.






CPS launched their first community solar project in 2016 and then doubledowned in 2019.

CPS is working directly with the City of San Antonio to effectuate SA's ambitious clean energy and climate plan.








2018 Energy Generation Resources Nebraska Customers



*Qualifying Local Generation (QLG) includes renewable energy facilities installed by our wholesale customers and in NPPD retail communities. NPPD has long been a leader in carbon-free generation, largely through the operation of large, regional nuclear plants.
