

Inaugural CEO Roundtable Scramble Golf Tournament Rules of Competition

Format

- Four-person scramble tournament.

Scramble Rules (all golf rules shall conform to USGA Rules)

- All team members tee off on each hole and then decide which tee shot they like the best and mark the spot with a tee or ball marker.
- Men tee off from the white tees and women from the red tees.
- If a team has only three players, then one player may hit two shots from each position on the hole.
- The other team members pick up their balls and place them within one club length (no closer to the hole) of the marked spot. Each team member hits their next shot from the chosen spot of the prior shot.
- The selected ball should also be marked on the putting green. Other team members must place their balls within one foot (no closer to the hole) of the marked spot.
- The first ball to go in the hole counts for the team score. When putting, once any ball is holed out, no further strokes count.
- **There are no gimme putts.**
- If the ball you choose to play is in a hazard (sand, water, etc.), the rough, or out of bounds, you cannot drop the ball outside of the hazard or rough even if relief is within one club length away.
- **Record a single score for the group per hole.**

Mulligans

- Each player will be given one mulligan to start the round.
- A player who has a mulligan available may use the mulligan on any shot, including putts.
- Mulligans, if available, may be used for all contest holes.

Course Etiquette

- **Please rake all bunkers, fix all ball marks on greens, and repair all divots.**
- **Please maintain the pace of play. Stay immediately behind the group in front of you.**

Contests

- **Longest Drive – Men/Women:** Longest drive wins a prize.
- **Closest to the Pin:** Golfer whose drive stops closest to the pin (flag) wins a prize.
- **Longest Putt (Team):** One long shot (50-75 feet) is set up on the putting green. Players record their distance from the hole on the proximity marker. The team with the highest total team (4 shots) distance wins a prize.
- **Best Team Score**

Tournament Competition

- The winning team will be determined by the lowest 18-hole score.
- In the event of a tie at the end of the competition, the winning team will be determined in card-match in which scores on the 18th hole will be compared.
- If the scores on the 18th hole are the same, then the scores on the 17th hole will be used, and so on, in reverse order, until a low score is identified.
