On his first day in office, President Biden issued a series of executive orders (EO) to freeze and review Trump Administration regulations and actions, including <u>Protecting Public Health and the Environment and Restoring Science to Tackle the Climate Crisis</u>. This EO directs the EPA and other agencies to immediately review agency actions taken over the last four years. The Biden White House also published a <u>List of Agency Actions for Review</u>, referencing more than 100 regulations and other executive actions issued by the previous administration that the new administration will scrutinize over the coming days.
