In addition to the public power rebate, customers can also get up to \$7,500 in federal electric vehicle (EV) tax credits. *(Additional state and local savings may also be available)*

To claim the rebate, head to PublicPower.org/EVrebates and print the rebate flyer. Bring the flyer, proof of eligible residency, and your current electric bill (or employee ID or a letter on letterhead if you work for [Utility Name]) to your local dealer. Find your local dealer at NissanUSA.com.
