Austin, Texas, June 11, 2019 — City of Danville Utilities in Danville, Virginia received an American Public Power Association E.F. Scattergood System Achievement Award at the Association's national conference in Austin, Texas. This award honors Association member systems that have enhanced the prestige of public power utilities through sustained achievement and customer service.

Danville Utilities is a regional public power leader, an active participant in the American Public Power Association's Legislative Rally, and a member of American Municipal Power's board of trustees. The utility has a variety programs and projects that provide reliable energy, a diverse power supply portfolio, and offers many benefits to the community and its customer-owners. Its most recent success is the Kentuck Solar Project – a six-megawatt solar array that brings renewable resources to the community. Danville Utilities has a locally owned hydroelectric plant, and is a participant in AMP's hydro projects, the largest deployment of run-of-the-river hydro in the country.
