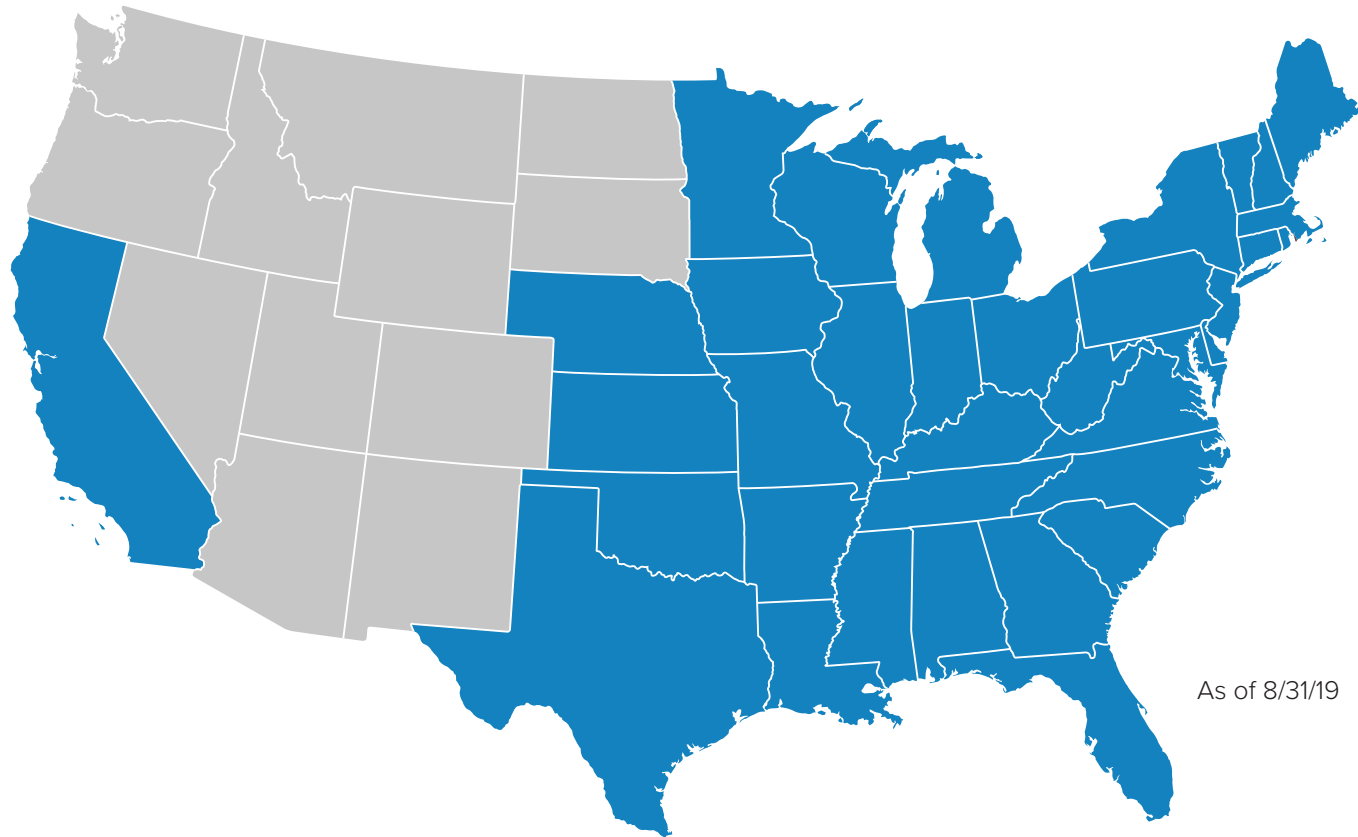


Hurricane Dorian: Mutual Assistance Networks Activated

While Hurricane Dorian continues to change track, investor-owned electric companies, public power utilities, and electric cooperatives in Florida, Georgia, and the Carolinas have activated their emergency response plans, continue to pre-stage equipment and resources, and are mobilizing mutual assistance workers in the event that the storm impacts their service territories.

Mutual assistance is a hallmark of the electric power industry, and workers from **at least 36 states, DC, and Canada** are standing by to restore power to customers affected by Dorian.
